## Stary Day Dress



## Loom:

4" Hazel Rose Multi Square for dress.

2"x 6" Multi Bookmark Loom for headband.

## Yarn:

Fingering,

I used Knit
Picks Palette,
about 145
yards, or a little
over half a skein
for dress and
headband.

## Other:

3-4 snaps

I used 4 buttons on the dress and 3 on the headband. These are decoration only.

Weave eight 4" squares in bias weave.

Weave two 4" squares using this pattern.

9. W2, U3,\*O1, U3\* x3, W14

10. W16, U3, \*O1, U3\* x3

13. W2 U3, O1, U3, x2, W22

14. W24, U3, O1, U3

16. Weave Plain.





The dress consists of three rows of four squares.





have the pattern stitch and the center row is made up of the diagonally woven squares, which give the dress some flexibility for the waist. The top and bottom rows are lapped over the center row of bias squares and top-stitched in place. The diagram shows the layout of the dress. The dotted lines indicate side and shoulder seams.

To assemble the dress, sew top row of squares together, starting with the two patterned squares facing each other, as shown. Then sew the two plain squares to these center squares, sewing a one inch seam, leaving the remaining seam open to form the sleeve openings.

For the center row, sew the four bias woven squares together.

Sew the bottom pattern row together as shown.

Assemble the three tiers as shown in the diagram with the patterned rows top stitched over the row of plain squares.

Sew shoulder seams and back seam. The back seam will go from hem to about midway of the center row.

The dress is finished with four star-shaped, decorative buttons sewn on the front center seam and four snaps to close the back opening. Sew on the snaps, over lapping the back of the dress.

The head band is two 2" x 6" rectangles.

Pattern stitch for headband on 2" x 6" Multi Bookmark Loom

- 1. Weave plain
- 2. U3, \*O1, U3\*
- 3. W2, U3, \*O1, U3\*, W2
- 4-15. Repeat rows 2 and

16.Weave plain

Sew rectangles end to end.

Using an appropriate sized needle, pick up stitches in each picot at one end and knit about one inch of ribbing, working two rows of knit followed by two rows of purl, repeat as necessary. Try the head band on your doll to determind the needed length of ribbing to fit around her head. Bind off and stitch to other end of head band. Or you can just sew a bit of elastic to each end to fit.

I used some of the star buttons to decorate the headband.
